

Learn How to Build a Wooden Kayak or Canoe



Starts February 3rd, 2009



Learn how to build a fine wood/epoxy canoe using the strip-built technique. Students will work as a group to build a 15' Prospector Ranger canoe, originally designed by the Chestnut Canoe Company. Each class session includes hands-on demonstration and application of techniques. Building methods will transfer between kayaks, canoes, duck, and drift boats. Parents with children older than 12 are encouraged to sign up. Greg Bridges teaches the same class through COCC in the fall and has a wait list.
