Lava Lands Visitor Center Now Open

Will Open on Weekends in May

BEND – Beginning tomorrow, the Deschutes National Forest's Newberry National Volcanic Monument Lava Lands Visitor Center will open on weekends in May.

On May 5, 2012 the Visitor Center, located on South Hwy 97, approximately 10 miles south of Bend, will open on weekends and the Memorial Day Holiday, May 28. Beginning on May 31 through June 30, 2012 the Visitor Center will be open Thursday to Monday and starting July 1, 2012 it will open daily. Hours for the Visitor Center are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Visitors will enjoy a new 3-D topographic model of Newberry National Volcanic Monument at the Visitor Center. In addition, upgrades are being done to the Trail of Molten Land and repairs are being made to the upper viewing platform at Lava Butte. Both the trail and the platform will be closed during May to allow for construction.

Parking at the Visitor Center requires a recreation pass and there is no accommodation for oversized vehicles when the Visitor Center is closed.

Visitors may access picnic sites, open trails and Lava Butte by foot or bike when the Visitor Center is not open.

Directions:

From Bend, OR, travel south on Highway 97 approximately 6 miles south of Exit 143 Baker/Knott Rd. Turn right into pocket lane when you see the Lava Lands site sign.

From La Pine, OR, travel north on Highway 97. Take Exit 151/Cottonwood Rd. Turn right after exiting. Continue on Forest Service Road 9703 for about 2 miles passing Lava River Cave. Turn right after underpass to Lava Lands Visitor Center Welcome Station. If you miss Exit 151, proceed north to Exit 143 Baker/Knot Rd. and follow southbound directions.
